    - High number of calls – 59 -36 berlin, 19 orange. Another fatal accident on 96. Received @ \$33,000 insurance claim for truck. New truck will be striped, and lights installed, etc. There is a CD for \$25,000 for the fire department that should be used towards the truck. Wittenbach and Fox will bring this up at the next fire board meeting.
    - New employee hired, Ryan Roderick for the fire department.
    - Amended the resolution for the cost recovery. There is about \$10,000 to the company that should be coming to the fire department soon.
    - Matt wants to give the fireman more money – currently is \$20 per call. He wants to give them \$20 per hour. There needs to be more money in the operating costs to cover the increasing costs of business. More discussion needs to take place and data shown before a decision can be made and voted on.
    - Assessor- The PA-660 audit is complete.
10. New Business- Need to appoint a new Interim Supervisor to finish out the term. Wittenbach nominated Cody – Rollcall vote – Wittenbach, Fox, McBride voted yes. Carried. Cody will serve the remaining term as township supervisor. Board needs to fill the trustee position and the Zoning Board of Appeals.

11. Old Business- Cemetery bid – Cody will ask more questions. The bid is a bit higher than we expected – tabled until next meeting.
